Between the various affiliates, approximately 20 seminars, conferences, and pre-conference events are conducted each year, with hundreds of combined participants, who apply what they have learned to train other individuals going into the missions field.**

**The various affiliate organizations conduct their own Community Health Evangelism and Neighborhood Transformation programs.
